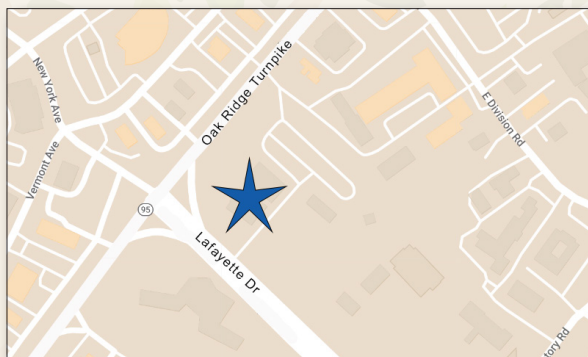
- assists roughly 7,000 individuals each year

How to Support ADFAC through Planned Giving

Bequest (Will)

A popular and simple option, you can name ADFAC as a beneficiary in your will. You can leave a specific amount, or a percentage.

Retirement Designation

For some, retirement assets can be the heaviest taxed in an estate. Naming ADFAC as a beneficiary can avoid taxation.

Life Insurance

Name ADFAC as the beneficiary of a new or existing life insurance policy. The amount you pay in premiums is tax-deductible.

Securities

Donate stocks, bonds, and mutual funds to ADFAC and receive tax benefits based on the fair market value of the assets.

Charitable Gift Annuity

Receive annuity payments for life with ADFAC receiving the remainder.
